

Did You Sign Up?

In 2012 the Department implemented a mass communication system called NIXLE. Over the past couple of years the program has been used to notify subscribers of road closures, detours, major events, and other information. The Department recognizes the need to provide quick and concise information to the public in certain circumstances. The program will only be successful if we can get the community to sign up for the service. The service is free and requires nothing more than signing up for either text or email notifications, or both. The enrollment is quite simple, go to NIXLE.com and select the "sign up free" button. You will then be prompted to enter the phone number and/or email address to receive the notifications.

Communication is a key element for any major activity whether planned or not. The Department believes NIXLE will be instrumental in getting the information out quickly. The school system utilizes a mass communication program that provides a mass message for school related matters and we rely on that information. In the same way the Department wants to provide information quickly and accurately. So please take a moment to go to the website and sign up for text and/or email notification. The Department will only send out alerts in crucial situations that require the rapid sharing of information. The Department will send out a "test" message on Friday, February 28th so all subscribers can ensure they receive the text/email transmission.
