


PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP-OFF

In partnership with the Coffee County Anti-Drug Coalition and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration providing a safe and anonymous means to dispose of unused and expired prescription drugs.

The Tullahoma Police Department, in partnership with the Coffee County Anti-Drug Coalition (CCADC), and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), provide citizens with a safe and anonymous way to dispose of expired and unused prescriptions drugs. The Police Department maintains a collection box in the lobby of the police department that is available to citizens on a 24/7 basis. Citizens need to simply bring the prescription drugs to the department lobby and drop the medication into the container. The department also has a container for sharp instruments such as syringes.

1. Drop packaged medication in box.
2. Place needles in "SHARPS" container on wall.
3. All liquid medications must be tightly closed.
4. No Cans or Glass Bottles



The Police Department will destroy all medications in a manner approved by state law.

The prescription drug drop-off program was approved by the Board of Mayor and Alderman on March 21, 2011.
